You are invited to participate in Professional Development for Integrated Inquiry (PDI<sup>2</sup>) workshops at the Madren Conference Center on the campus of Clemson University in Clemson, South Carolina. The workshops for summer, 2009, are as follows:

**Mastering Basic Facts and Computation (Grades 2-5)    July 23**  
**Connecting Mathematics and Literacy (Grades K-2)    July 24**

The workshops are designed for instructional leaders and classroom teachers. Participants will experience research-based professional development that includes hands-on investigations and reflective conversations.

**The Mastering Basic Facts and Computation** workshop for Grades 2-5 is designed to share strategies for improving fluency with basic facts for all students. The workshop also provides teachers with strategies for mastery of whole number addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.

**The Connecting Mathematics and Literacy** workshop provides teachers with strategies for connecting mathematics to reading and writing in the early childhood grades. Participants will investigate mathematics journals, reading strategies for the content areas, and using literature to connect to mathematics.
